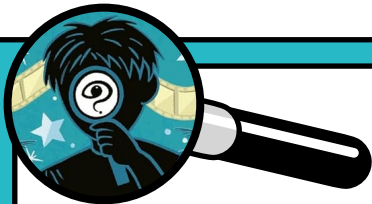
## *Knot a Problem*

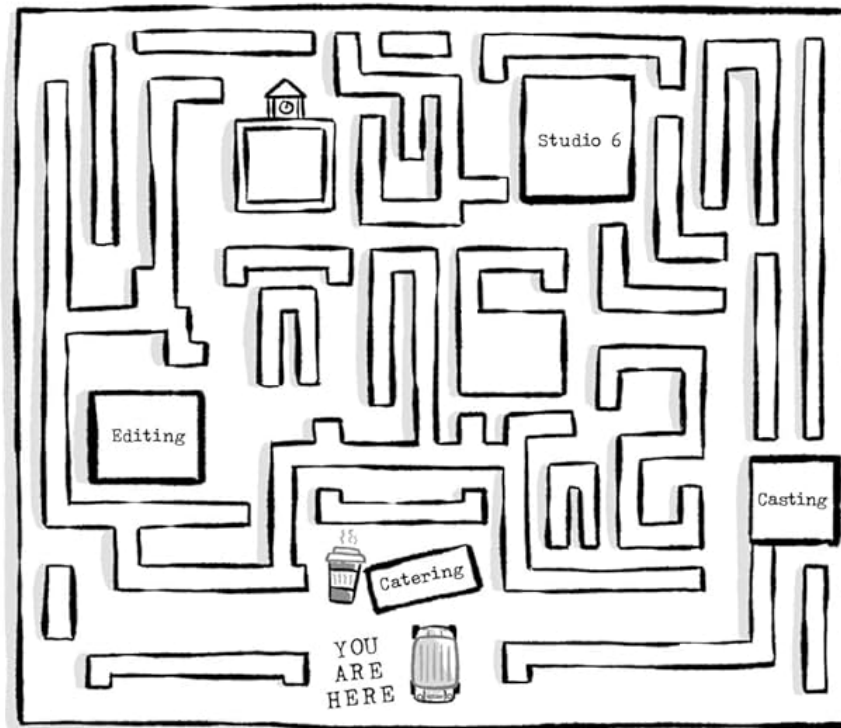


## *The Murder Maze*

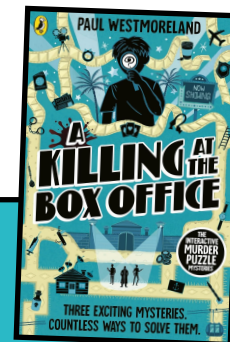
*A Killing at the Box Office* takes Arlo to Hollywood – home of movie stars and all kinds of puzzling mysteries.

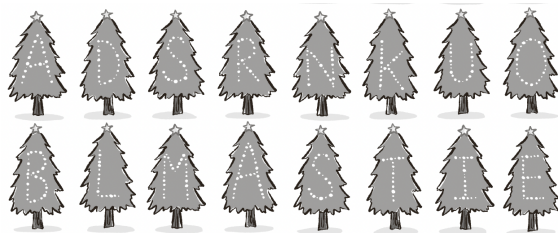

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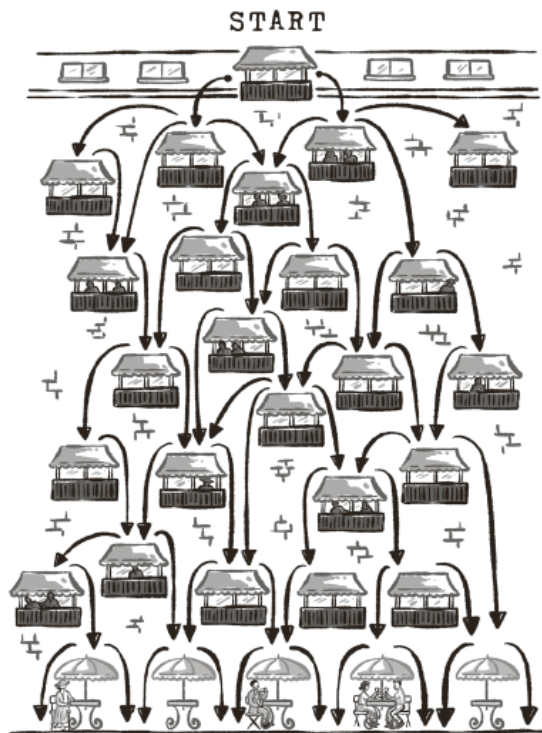
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## *Scooter Spotter*

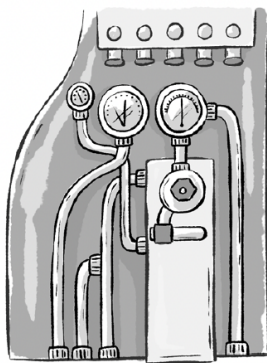
## *The Crank Dilemma*

**1** All the pipes fit into place. You just have to overlap a couple to reconnect the boiler.

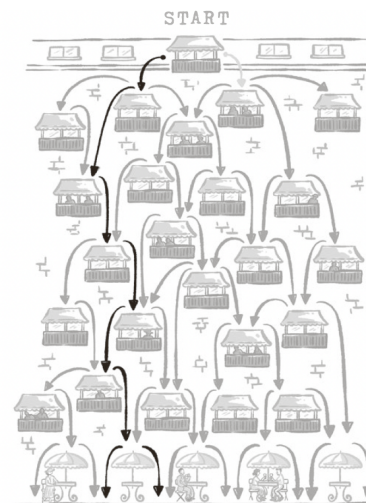
**2** If you pull loose end A, the knot will come undone. Pulling loose end B will tighten it.

**3** The fastest way to check all three locations is to visit Casting, then Studio 6, then Editing.

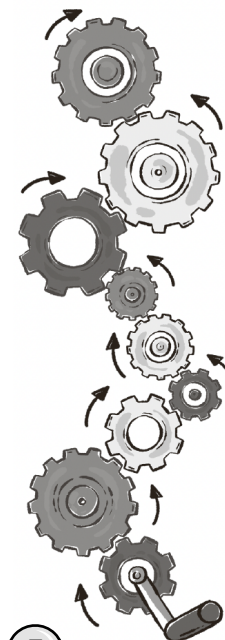
**4** The message in the fairy lights is:  
ARLO BANKS MUST DIE



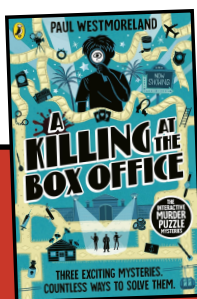
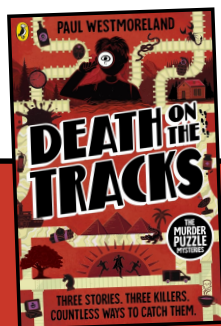
**5** There are seven black scooters. If you stop them all you will help Arlo recover his satchel.



**6** The safest number of jumps down the balconies is seven. Any less will result in you jumping too far and hurting yourself, and if you take more the hit man will get away.



**7** To open the shutter and escape from the truck, you need to turn the cranking handle clockwise.
